



Passport Fees

With effect from 11 April 2011, the arrangement whereby citizens aged 65 and over were exempted from passport fees has been withdrawn and standard application fees will apply.

Customers resident in the island of Ireland are encouraged to submit their applications by the express passport services offered by An Post and the Post Office in Northern Ireland. This is the quickest and best value way for customers resident in Ireland to obtain their passport. The fee for applications submitted in Ireland, other than through An Post and Post Office express services, will increase by €15.”
